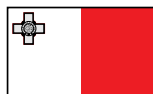

What is the EU Disability Card?

The EU Disability Card shows that you have a certified disability status in Malta and entitles you to access benefits offered by various organisations to people with disabilities in each of the eight participating Member States, including Malta.

Which are the participating countries in this initiative?

The participating countries are Belgium, Cyprus, Estonia, Finland, Italy, Malta, Slovenia and Romania.

In 2015, the Commission for the Rights of Persons with Disability (CRPD) started implementing the 'EU Disability Card in Malta' project, which is co-funded by the Rights, Equality and Citizenship Programme (REC) of the European Union.

The EU Disability Card is being introduced in eight Member States, each through their own project and co-financed by the Rights, Equality and Citizenship Programme (REC). Please note that benefits vary between countries.

The card includes the name, surname and date of birth of the holder, a serial number and an expiry date, as well as the holder's passport photograph. It also includes certain security features and the initials of the member state issuing the card. The card also has 'EU Disability Card' printed in braille.
