PA/00059/18 – Qormi – To separate existing print shop into two separate warehouses (Class 6A). Application to include internal and external alterations, addition of store at basement level, replacing of apertures and fixing of shop signs.

On Friday 26th July 2019 the Test of Reasonableness Board (TORB) discussed a request for exemption received on a minor amendment on the above indicated permit. Perit Mark Camilleri and Mr. Jason Grech were present on behalf of the applicant.

Exemption was requested on lifts since warehouse is going to be used solely to store trucks and heavy materials.

CRPD had objected on the following non-conforming elements:

Parking:

- Accessible Parking has not been provided
- Accessible Parking is not clearly marked with the wheelchair logo and dimensions

Lifts:

- Accessible Lifts have not been provided

Taking all arguments in consideration, the TORB concluded that it is **REASONABLE** to exempt as long as there is no change of use.
