PA/04168/19 – Kalkara – To sanction variations from previous approved permit PA00766/13. Proposal to retain approved use as clubhouse for Kalkara Football Club and to include spectator terrace at roof level overlooking football ground and ancillary cooking facilities at semi-basement level together with minor internal and external alterations.

On Friday 24th April 2020, the Test of Reasonableness Board (TORB) discussed a request for exemption received on the above indicated permit. Mr. Norman Clews, Perit Roderick Spiteri, Perit Karl Grech Seychell, Eng. Rene Camilleri and Eng. Brian Cauchi were present on behalf of the applicant.

CRPD objected on the following non-conforming elements:

- From specifications provided, the clear and internal lift cabin dimensions for proposed passenger lift could not be determined for vetting report. Also it was noted that clear opening for lift does not conform to the AADG2011.

Exemption requested on the proposed lift from conforming to AADG 2011 as lift is existing and will only be used to access the kitchen while that the rest of the premises will supposedly be accessible for all.

Taking all arguments in consideration, the TORB concluded that it is **NOT REASONABLE** to exempt.
